
Travel Information

The hotel is located just off the M4, at Junction 32, and has plenty of free parking; take the A4054 turning at the north side of the roundabout. Cardiff International Airport is located just over 16 miles from the hotel and Cardiff Station is just over 6 miles away. From the main station, you could either grab a taxi or take the No 132 bus (which is located a 3 minute walk from the station), the bus takes approximately 30 minutes to reach the hotel.
